

Amarinth pumps up order book

Petrochemical pump maker, Amarinth, has landed a contract from Denmark's Dong after appointing Norway's TUROteknikk as its agent for the Scandinavian market.

Amarinth will supply three new API 610 pumps to DONG Energy. These pumps will replace worn out Girdlestone water injection pumps that are used on oil platforms in the North Sea Siri field.
